Overview:

The two-day SSSTS course provides supervisors with an understanding of health, safety, welfare and environmental issues, as well as their legal responsibilities relevant to their work activities. It highlights the requirement to promote health & safety and supervise effectively. On successful completion of the training and assessments candidates will be issued with a CITB Site Safety Certificate which is valid for 5 years.

Aim:

The aim of this course is to ensure that all those given supervisory responsibilities understand; why they are carrying out their duties, what is expected of them and to ensure they can contribute to the safety of the workplace.

Content:

On successful completion delegates will be able to;

- Understand the problems of the industry.
- Understand how health & safety law is structured and how it applies to supervisors.
- Identify how their supervisory role fits with the management structure in controlling site safety.
- Carry out risk assessments and understand the need for method statements.
- Carry out effective site inductions, toolbox talks and method statements briefing.
- Monitor site activities effectively.
- Understand the importance of a timely intervention when bad practice is identified.
