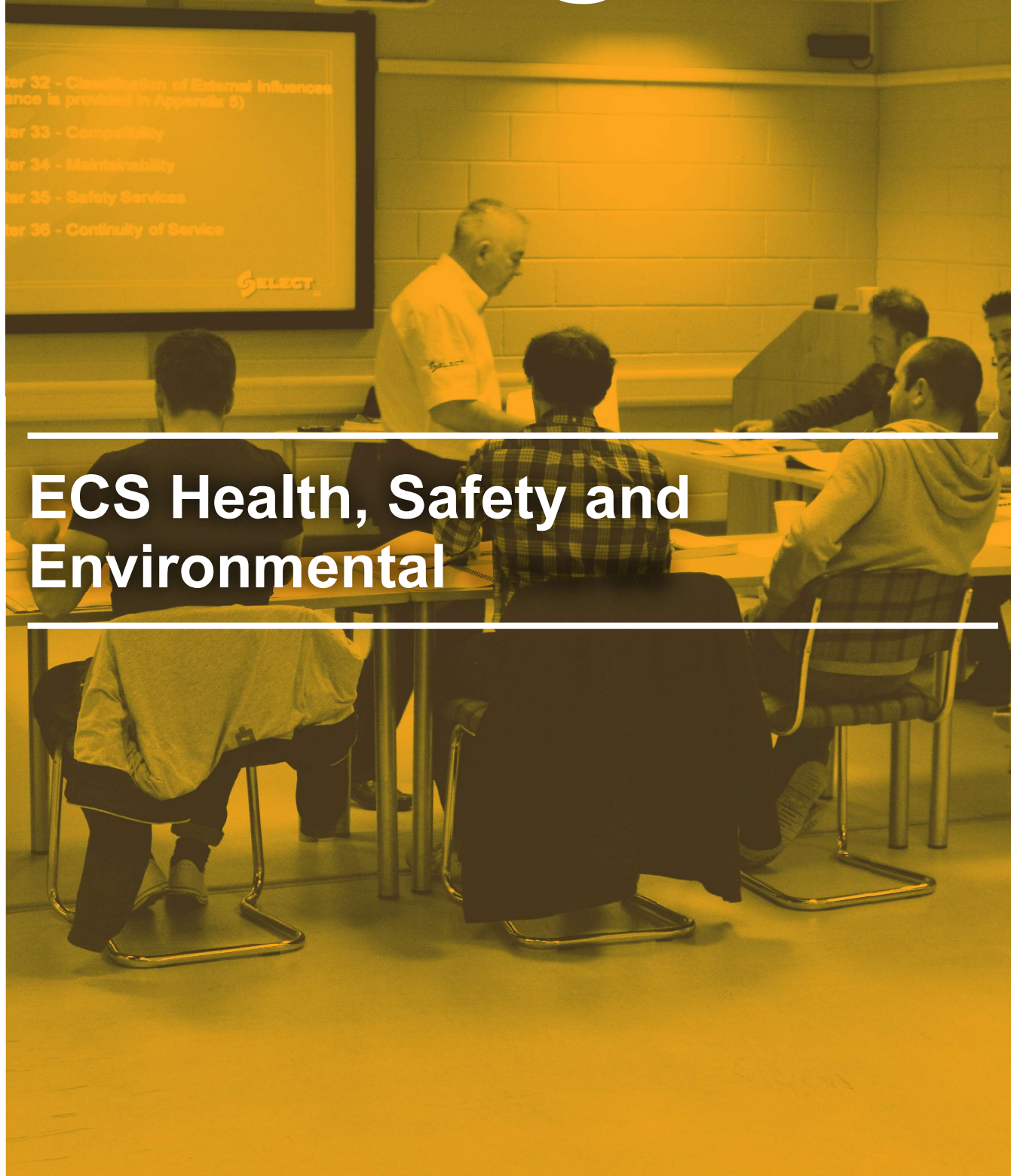

ECS Health, Safety and Environmental

Overview:

This one day assessed course is intended to update electrotechnical personnel on electrical and general construction industry health, safety and environmental standards in line with the Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) skill card requirements. **This course is suitable for Applicants applying for ECS gold cards only.**

Aim:

To update electrotechnical personnel in construction industry health, safety and environmental standards. On completion of the course participants will attempt the Electrotechnical Certification Scheme (ECS) multiple choice question paper. The invigilator will return the assessments to the Scottish Joint Industry Board (SJIB) and the results will be forwarded to the participant's company within three to four weeks. Participants who successfully complete the assessment will be awarded a certificate that will be acceptable to SJIB for renewal of their ECS card, to include the ECS Assessed mark and CSCS hologram.
